## SAA Publications Citation Analysis Dennis Riley - November 2012

In conducting this citation analysis I searched for the 68 titles published by SAA in two different databases – World of Knowledge and Scopus. Unfortunately, the results from World of Knowledge were not sufficient to draw any meaningful conclusions. The following, therefore, is based solely on search results retrieved from Scopus as of November 2012. Thus, this analysis only reflects the accuracy and reality documented by Scopus and the general caveat applies that SAA titles may have been cited in publications not included in Scopus or in such a way as to not be reflected in a basic title search.

Furthermore, I did not differentiate between citations that used editions of titles published by entities other than SAA. For example, the Dutch Manual was cited 29 times for all editions, but only nine times was the SAA edition cited. By not differentiating between which version or edition was cited, the following analysis hopefully still reflects each title's relevancy to the field.

All but 10 of the 68 titles are cited in articles, conference proceedings, or other publications that are indexed by Scopus. Which means that 85% of SAA publications have been cited at least once.

Of the 10 titles that have not been cited, four are brochures (two in Spanish) and one is a thesaurus. Another three titles not yet cited were published in 2011 or 2012, which may be too current to have been used as a source by another author, although four titles published in 2011 have been cited at least once. *Architectural Records: Managing Design and Construction*, published in 2006, is the only full-fledged book that has been in circulation for a number of years that has yet to be cited according to Scopus.

Of the 58 titles that have been cited, 11 have been cited only once and another 19 have been cited between 2-9 times, which account for 52% of titles that have been cited. Conversely, 28 (48%) of the titles have been cited more than 10 times.

The top five titles to be cited are: *Modern Archives: Principles & Techniques* – 71 citations *Glossary of Archival and Records Terminology* – 67 citations *Describing Archives: A Content Standard* – 52 citations *Archives in the Ancient World* – 39 citations *Selecting and Appraising Archives and Manuscripts* – 31 citations

Curiously, four of these titles are designated as out of print.

The top five titles cited that are not designated as out of print are: Selecting and Appraising Archives and Manuscripts – 31 citations Manual for the Arrangement and Description of Archives – 29 citations Varsity Letters: Documenting Modern Colleges and Universities – 29 citations Political Pressure and the Archival Record – 26 citations Understanding Archives and Manuscripts – 25 citations All of the titles designated as either AFS II or Classic publications have been cited at least once, with most of them being cited 16 times or more. These titles account for 48% (13 titles) of the 28 most cited titles. Only two – one AFS II (*Managing Archival and Manuscript Repositories*) and one Classic (*Lester J. Cappon and the Relationship of History, Archives and Scholarship*) – have only been cited once.

Of the 795 citations, not surprisingly, the publication in which SAA titles were most frequently cited was *American Archivist*, with 232 instances (29%). The other publications in which SAA publications were cited 10 or more times include: *Archival Science* – 91 instances *Journal of Archival Organization* – 76 instances *Journal of the Society of Archivists* – 47 instances *Libraries and the Cultural Record* - 16 instances *Library Resources and Technical Services* – 14 instances *Journal of Information Ethics* - 13 instances *Records Management Journal* – 13 instances

An assortment of other information services related journals (i.e. libraries, computer science, museums, records management) account for an additional 200 instances. Overall, information management related journals account for 88% of the citations found in Scopus. Conversely, this means only 12% of citations are from journals outside the general audience of SAA publications.

Finally, it should be noted that a number of articles cite multiple SAA publications. In total, 168 different articles account for 450 citations, which means that about a third of the articles that cite SAA publications account for 57% of all citations.
