The material included in the Dairy and the US Congress is our attempt at making

available a large body of evidence on a given topic. George Aiken served on the

Agriculture Committee in the Senate from 1941-1975 and was extensively involved in

issues of concern to Vermont dairy farmers. Our selection and delivery of this group of

materials has been unique in relation to other digital collections we have built.

We are attempting to digitize a large volume of material, everything that has no potential

rights issues and has some significant content. We do not have the staff to create

descriptive metadata at the item level. So what the user sees is the equivalent of a folder

of material. There is a table of contents to aid navigation, as well as descriptions and

subject headings at the folder level, but the user still needs to scroll through all of the

documentation. This approach more or less follows a traditional archival description

model, but it may not be what people necessarily expect from digital collections at this

time.
