

## IMPACT OF NHPRC IN OHIO

*The National Historical Publications and Records Commission (NHPRC) promotes the preservation and use of America's documentary heritage essential to understanding our democracy, history, and culture. Since 1964, the NHPRC has awarded \$207 million to 4,900 projects in all 50 states and special jurisdictions.*

### Total Cost of Projects supported by NHPRC in Ohio:

- **\$3,493,315 – Total Project Funds**
- **\$1,632,561 - Direct Federal Grants**
- **\$1,860,754 - State and Local Contributions**

### Projects of Special Value to the State of Ohio:

*The NHPRC has played a unique role in supporting historical PUBLICATIONS and RECORDS projects of special value to Ohio including:*

- **Establish Network of Archives in Ohio** – support to establish or enhance archives at such institutions as the Daytona Art Institute, Toledo Museum of Art, Oberlin College, University of Cincinnati, Rutherford B. Hayes Presidential Center, Kent State, Ohio University, Wright State and many others.
- **State Archives Support** – funding to help enhance the state archives' capacity to preserve and make known its holdings and to prepare for emergencies.
- **Local records in Ohio** – support to help organize, preserve, manage, and make accessible local records throughout the state.
- **Access to the Papers of Diverse Americans** – project and/or academic press support for the papers of such notable figures as Clarence Mitchell, Jr., Salmon P. Chase, Roger B. Taney, Rutherford B. Hayes, Robert A. Taft, Theodore M. Berry, Samuel Milton Jones, and the American Jewish Archives at Hebrew Union College.
- **Heritage support for Local Ohio communities** – support for preserving historical records held at smaller Ohio repositories.
