Staff Q2: Operations Report (Prepared by: Astoria Edwards, Assistant Director, Foundation)

The focus for FY25 is donor engagement, enhancing the donor experience, and sharing the impact of the Foundation's Grant Programs. The Society & Foundation utilizes Nimble AMS to manage members. Staff are working with Nimble AMS support to begin their pilot program, "Donations in Experience Cloud." The features included online donation forms, recurring gifts, abandoned cart reminders, microsites dedicated to individual funds or appeals, peer-to-peer campaigns, text-to-give, personalized thank-you messages, predictive analytics, and campaign thermometers. Anticipate implementation to begin in the 3rd quarter of FY25.

Contribution Report

Current FY25 donation trends as of December 2024 indicate that the Catalyst Fund and NDRFA Fund are trending upward compared to FY24 and FY23.

Overall Trends (FY23 - FY25):

- Total funding is declining:
 - o FY23: \$66,424.00
 - o FY24: \$39,818.01 (↓40% from FY23)
 - FY25 (as of Dec 2024): \$36,382.40 (↓9% from FY24 so far)
- Record count also dropping:
 - FY 2023: 632 transactions.
 - FY 2024: 549 transactions
 - FY 2025 (so far): 466 transactions

Fund-Specific Insights:

- Stable or Increasing Funds:
 - o Catalyst Fund (\$15,149 \rightarrow \$17,243 \rightarrow \$17,608.91) ↑16% since FY23
 - o Mosaic Scholarship (\$17,652 → \$5,432 → \$6,511.11) \uparrow 20% from FY24

- o Linda J. Henry Fund (\$988 → \$2,043 → \$192.91) \downarrow 90% from FY24
- Harold T. Pinkett Student of Color Award (\$5,810 → \$1,844 → \$1,828.91) ↓68% since FY23




Figure 1: Current FY25 Donor Contribution

The quarterly donor contribution report provides a detailed summary of donations received from FY23 to January 14, 2025.

In Q1 of FY25, The Development Committee prioritized three key appeals, Mosaic, Catalyst, and NDRFA, aligning their efforts to maximize engagement and contributions.

In Q2 of FY25, the committee focused its fundraising initiatives on the Catalyst Fund, channeling resources into the Giving Tuesday campaign and End-of-Year appeals to drive donor participation.

- □ Catalyst Fund (UR): Significant increase in Q2 FY23 (\$11,326.00) compared to Q1 FY23 (\$595.00). Donations peaked in FY23 Q2 but dropped substantially in FY24 Q2 and FY25 Q2, showing fluctuating trends.
- □ Donald Peterson Student Scholarship Award (R): Low donations throughout, with peaks in Q2 FY23 (\$200.00) and Q1 FY25 (\$122.91). Q2 FY25 showed a decline to \$50.00.
- ☐ F. Gerald and Elsie Ham Scholarship (R): Highest donation in Q2 FY23 (\$960.00). Consistent decreases in FY24 and FY25, with the lowest in Q2 FY25 (\$145.00).

- □ Harold T. Pinkett Student of Color Awards (R): Donations were highest in Q1 FY23 (\$3,089.00). FY24 and FY25 saw decreased and inconsistent trends, with the lowest in Q1 FY25 (\$422.91).
- ☐ Linda J. Henry Fund (UR): Consistently low donations across all quarters.Q2 FY25 (\$0.00) had no donations
- ☐ Margaret Cross Norton Fund (UR): Notable peak in Q2 FY23 (\$6,725.00). Donations remained modest in FY24 and FY25, with minimal fluctuation.
- Mosaic Scholarship (R): Peak donations occurred in Q2 FY23 (\$11,900.00). Significant decline in FY24 and FY25, with Q2 FY25 only receiving \$620.00.
- □ National Disaster Recovery Fund for Archives (R): High initial donations in Q2 FY23 (\$1,650.00). Subsequent years saw decreased and inconsistent donations, with a notable drop in Q2 FY25 (\$2,543.00).
- □ Philip Hamer & Elizabeth Hamer-Kegan Award (R): Fluctuating trends with the highest donations in Q2 FY23 (\$375.00). Donations remained consistently low after FY23, with Q2 FY24 showing slight improvement (\$125.00).




Figure 2: 1st Quarter FY 23 - Jan 14 2025 Trends




Figure 3: : 2nd Quarter FY 23 - Jan 14 2025 Trends
