Certificate Program Updates

- 9 people renewed their DAS Certificate this quarter. There were no initial certificates awarded, as this quarter did not host a DAS Comprehensive examination window. The exam is offered in January, May, and September.
- 4 people earned A&D Certificates this quarter, while 1 renewed.
- The DAS Subcommittee continues to work with psychometrics consultants DAINIS and Co. on the Job Task Analysis.
- Staff and the DAS Subcommittee are implementing final steps to launch the pilot "Option B" renewal process and OAIS prerequisite. Look for more information in February 2025 for the 2-year "Option B" process

Highlights and Discussion

- This quarter, we offered in-person courses and one online closed course for five host organizations: Hong Kong Government Records Service, Texas State Library and Archives Commission, North Carolina Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, University of Pennsylvania, and the DC Public Library. Additionally, we offered Reappraising and Deaccessioning for the first time since 2018 and a newly revised version of the Teaching with Primary Sources course.
- Education assisted the Advocacy team in hosting a Storytelling Master Class with Micaela Blei in late October, in conjunction with Archives Awareness Month.
- The revised 90-minute Records Management Introduction course debuts at the end of January and will be available soon after for purchase as a recording.
