**Staff Report: Education

FY 2011 Summary

- Scheduled 58 programs.
- Offered four Web seminars at 175 sites with a total of 525 attendees.
- Offered 50 face-to-face programs with 1,190 attendees.
- Cancelled three workshops due to lack of registrants (see table).
- Cancelled Electronic Records Summer Camp.
- Secured 12 new hosts.
- See Table 1 for details on FY11 schedule.

Year-To-Date FY 2012 Summary

- Scheduled 48 programs.
- Offered two Web seminars at 72 sites with a total of 256 attendees.
- Offered three face-to-face programs with 76 attendees.
- Cancelled two workshops due to lack of registrants (see table).
- Secured 11 new hosts.

Activity Highlights Since May 2011

- Offering the May Web seminar, “Archon: Making It Work for You!” with a new subcontractor (Peach New Media) on a trial basis turned out very well! Based on that experience, we’ve offered three more Web seminars and were able to realize significant savings in the process. These offerings included:
 - 1) “Train the Trainer” at 8 sites with 10 attendees.
 - 2) “Archivists’ Toolkit™: Shortening the Path from Accession to Researcher” at 57 sites with a total of 200 attendees.
 - 3) “EAD Tips and Tricks: Repurposing EAD with SXML” at 15 sites with a total of 56 attendees.
- Finalized 18 additional workshops for FY 2012. The current “working list” of 13 workshops under consideration includes eight new contacts.

- Contributed to an MLIS grant, submitted by the University of Virginia, for funding of 20 scholarships per SAA EAC-CPF workshop to be offered seven times in different regions. SAA will be a subcontractor and participate in the scholarship selection committee and in coordinating sites, just like we do for other workshops.
- Relocated another pre-conference workshop off site due to unanticipated audio-visual costs. We now have five Annual Meeting workshops that are scheduled off site.

DAS Curriculum and Certificate Program

- Contacted developers for existing courses to create exams.
- Secured developers and contracts for:
 - 1) “Standards for Digital Archives” (Web seminar), scheduled for September 29.
 - 2) “Digital Curation: Creating an Environment for Success” on October 3.
 - 3) “Legal Issues in Digital Archives” in February.
 - 4) “Outreach for Digital Archives” on December 15.
 - 5) “Digital Forensics” on January 30.
 - 6) “Information Architecture” (Web seminar), scheduled for February 2012.
 - 7) “Preserving Digital Archives: Concepts and Competencies,” scheduled on August 23 (as a pre-con at *ARCHIVES 360°*) and which will have an exam by October.
- Worked with New England Archivists (NEA) on a model that enables archivists in that area to fulfill the DAS certificate requirements within the expected two-year time frame.
- Contacted Society of Southern California Archivists, Midwest Archives Conference, and Society of Southwest Archivists to implement the same or a similar model.
- Coordinated the first meeting (via conference call) of the DAS Subcommittee.
- Worked on a pricing structure in collaboration with my colleagues.
- Worked on CEU management with my colleagues.
- Worked with Nancy Beaumont to create the DAS Flyer.
- Worked with Amanda Look to “test drive” set up of exams, registration of test takers, and necessary reports in the Classmarker online testing service.
- Drafted a FAQ on DAS to be posted on the SAA website.
