Initial, ongoing and projects nearing completion have the following updates:

- **Decolonial Archival Futures** manuscript for the *Archival Futures* series is printed and currently in SAA warehouse, will roll out jointly with ALA for book event early in November 2023.
- *The Solo Archivist* manuscript is headed to final stage of editorial process (formatting, final content approval)
- *Lifting As They Climbed* (Booth/Brown) manuscript first draft is expected for completion in Q4 2023.
- *Teaching Primary Source Research Skills* (Thomas) manuscript is in second stage editorial process. Page proofs and cover draft. Up for publication in Q4 2023.
- 410 Measurable Learning Outcomes for Primary Source Literacy (Katz) has received and is working through first round draft edits. Expected Q4 2023.
- Reparative Description (Wisser/Hinkle) manuscript expected summer 2024.
- Special Collections Curatorship (Cuellar, Czebakow) manuscript expected summer 2024.
- ARCHIVAL FUNDAMENTALS SERIES III: Volume 6, Appraising and Acquiring Archives and Manuscripts (Wosh) being re-conceptualized with new authors and outline. Working with former authors and ed. Wosh on new suggestions and format.
- ARCHIVAL FUNDAMENTALS SERIES III: Volume 7, Introducing Archives and Manuscripts (Wosh) chapters delayed, being reconceptualized.
- Archival and Special Collections Facilities: Guidelines for Archivists, Librarians, Architects, and Engineers, REVISED EDITION still in process with Technical Subcommittee as of March 2021. No date yet for revision.
