Certificate Program Updates

- 27 DAS Certificates were awarded during the September exam cycle. 3 people renewed their DAS Certificate this quarter.
- Two people earned their A&D Certificate this period. There were no renewals.
- The DAS Subcommittee is beginning work this month with the psychometrician consultants, DAINIS, that we have engaged to complete a Job Task Analysis project, ensuring that the DAS program is keeping pace with developments in the field and skillsets required by employers.
- We have proposals from the Committee on Education, approved by Council in May 2023, to make improvements and adjustments to the A&D Certificate and Management Track. Timeline for implementation of these proposals awaits staff bandwidth and planning for backend Nimble updates.
- In FY25, we will also roll out the “Option B” renewal process for DAS Certificate holders and implement an OAIS prerequisites. Timelines forthcoming.

Highlights and Discussion

- The first fiscal quarter is typically slower than the rest of the year, allowing staff to focus on Annual Meeting prep during the summer months. This quarter, we offered two in-person courses – one Project Management “closed” course online with the Architect of the Capitol’s office and, for the first time since 2019, an in-person pre-conference workshop, Email Archiving. Email Archiving sold out with 35 attendees! We also hosted two career management courses, one paid, called Investing in You, and one free and featuring SAA CEO Jackie Price Osafo, talking about Building Your Brand. This free offering achieved maximum enrollment as well.
- Following last quarter’s offering of the one-day Records Management course with Brad Houston, we engaged the instructor to revise the 90-minute webinar on the same topic originally released in 2014. Look for that new product to appear in January 2025. We are continually updating older webcasts and courses for the “new normal” of online education, revisiting certificate program webinars as well as other content.

- We continue to serve the Hong Kong Government Records Service with customized online learning opportunities so that their team can complete requirements for DAS Certificates.
- On September 30, the project team submitted the final report on the Indigenizing Archival Training grant to the Mellon Foundation. This \$98,000 grant represented a herculean effort on the part of NAAS, the IAT Team, SAA and SAA Foundation staff. I look forward to future conversations with Mellon and thinking through the next iteration of IAT.
