




Demographic of users

 What are the characteristics of American archival workers who are and are not adopting Al/ML technologies to provide access to digital archival materials?




Current Use

 How are American archival workers currently using AI/ML tools to provide access to digital archival materials?




Planned Use

 What are American archival workers' planned use of AI/ML tools to provide access to digital archival materials?




Adoption

Questions for Survey Testers


- 1. How much time did it take for you to complete the survey?

- 4. Any questions needing tweaking?


Survey Distribution


Developed exhaustive list of 99 distinct groups for survey distribution


