This makes Towson one of the largest public universities in Maryland, and it still produces the most teachers of any university in the state. Evaluation Criteria

Crawling / captureprocess - How does it
work? What can it do?

Expertise needed – What do we need to know? What support is available?

Type and capacity of storage – Where do our captured files go? How are they stored?

Interaction with login
- protected sites – Can
it capture things like X
and Instagram?

Replay of captured sites – How can researchers use these resources in the future?

Cost – What do we pay for? How much? How often?














Results

Archiveweb.page was unable to scale to meet our needs in terms of capturing pages that were complex or dynamic, or that needed to be captured regularly.

CivicPlus and
Pagefreezer were not
cost-effective based
on the number of
accounts we hope to
preserve.

Archiveweb.page
desktop app is unable
to effectively bypass
login screens, and
CivicPlus and
Pagefreezer required
the personal login
information of each
account in order to

access them.

Direct download of data from **X** required greater access to account information than we normally have.

Recommendations

Preserving individual pages

 Archiveweb.page allows logged-in, one-time capture of social media pages via free browser extension and local storage of data

Managing institutional social media accounts

• CivicPlus or Pagefreezer allow near-real-time management of accounts with individual login information

Ongoing dynamic crawls

 Archive-It or Browsertrix allow individual or scheduled crawls of sites and store data on a subscription basis
