Key contact subcommittee report...wrote a handbook for managing KC. Made most documents public on the website. Revising the website information.

Career Development...40 sessions scheduled on resume counseling. Considering survey of participants. Might survey people in SAA as a whole as to why they don't participate in the Career Center. Thinking about virtual services that can be offered. Maybe skype mock interview or phone. Consider a web event on mock interviews or mentoring, or phone interviews.

Mentoring committee...81 proteges and 77 mentors. Consider a check in after the first 6 months to see how the mentor relationship is working. This would address unresponsive protégés. Also considering ways to understand what the protégés would expect from the mentoring relationship.

Navigator...she matched up about 20-30 matches. Feels like the numbers are down this year.

Reviewed times of subcommittee meetings. Expanding support to perhaps vendors contributing more \$\$\$ to attend the meetings. Looking to private foundations for meeting attendance support. Build an endowment.
