### *Highlights:*

- **Data Rescue Event, March 2017:** [DataRescue Chapel Hill](#) was organized by Sangeeta Desai--a student at the School of Information and Library Science--and librarians at UNC-CH in collaboration with DataRefuge, EDGI, and the Internet Archive's EOT Archive. On March 4, SCOSAA members attended and participated in web archiving and collaborative archival decision-making.
- **SNCA conference in Asheville, March 2017:** The Society of North Carolina Archivists meeting was in Asheville, NC in March. Several members of SCOSAA were in attendance and carpooled together. This event emphasized both professional development and social activities to help network within the state.



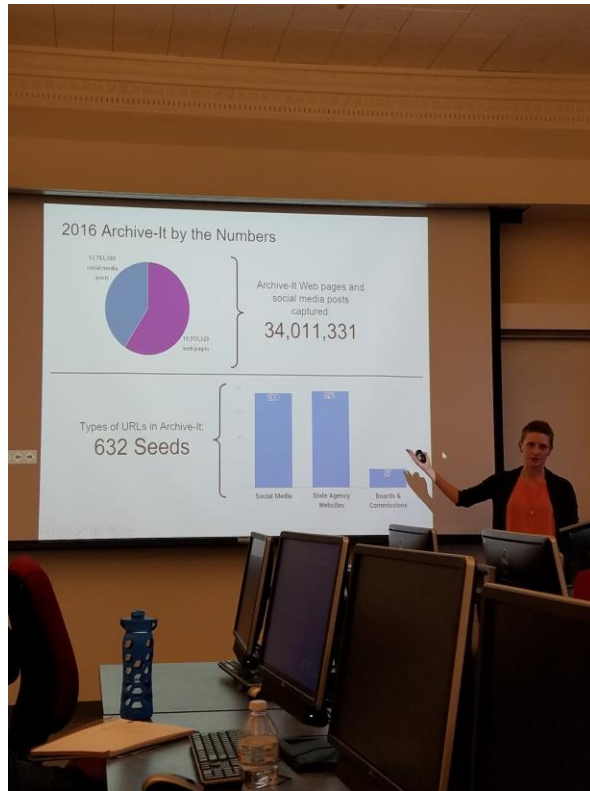
- **SCALA book sale, April 2017:** SCOSAA joined in the annual SCALA ([Student Chapter of ALA](#)) book sale in April to raise money for the upcoming year through sales of baked goods and handmade book plates.

- **Master's paper pane, May 2017:** In May, SCOSAA held a panel for archives students in their first year preparing to embark on their masters paper in their second year. We invited all the archives faculty at SILS, and two came, along with four students who had just completed their papers. This event highlighted the realities of writing a master's paper, and gave the first year students a lot of hints and tips on how to be successful in short amount of time. This was highly attended, with around 20 people in attendance.

- **NC digital archivists talk, November 2017:** In November, Andrea Green from the NC Department of Natural and Cultural Resources came and talked to SCOSAA members about social media archiving, and how her department is using tools such as Archive-It. With around 10 people in attendance, this event was a success. After her presentation, there was a short Q&A session, where those in attendance could ask about social media archiving in general and also any other questions about her position.

- **Test kitchen, November 2017:** To close out the semester, SCOSAA held a test kitchen event in November where participants picked a recipe from an archival collection and recreated it for others to try.
