Membership

SAASC NEWSLETTER

The newsletter was moved from MailPoet to Substack in February 2024 to avoid technical issues and to increase visibility. As of May 2024, the SAASC Newsletter has 232 subscribers, an increase from 139 in September 2023, a 67 percent increase.

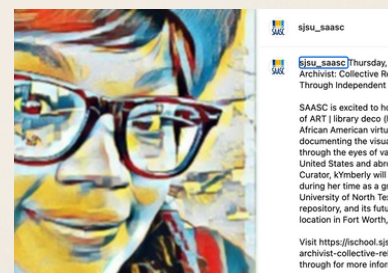


Events & Activities

Fifteen different virtual events and activities were presented throughout the academic school year. The selection of guest speakers was influenced by networking with professors, colleagues, and ARCHIVES*RECORDS 2023 presenters, and was intended to reflect our members' diverse archival interests, as gleaned from our biannual member surveys.

Fostering interaction and communication among members were key goals for the 2023-24 SAASC executive board. The guest speakers' sessions all included a dedicated Q&A session, allowing SAASC members to reflect on and engage with presenters' content in meaningful ways. Prior to the tour of SJSU's Archives & Special Collections, members were invited to request archival items to be pulled for a closer look. This event also concluded with a Q&A session, as did the biannual Member Meetings.

To this end, the Membership Director also organized several activities each semester: a virtual scavenger hunt, an Archives Madness tournament, and a Transcribe-a-Thon. These activities enabled members to get to know one another better, and were well received.



September

Fall Annual Member Meeting

The 2023-2024 SAASC Executive Board introduced themselves and reviewed plans and goals for the year, including upcoming events and activities; the blog, website, and *Archeota*; benefits of SAA membership, and how to stay connected to and involved with SAASC.

March

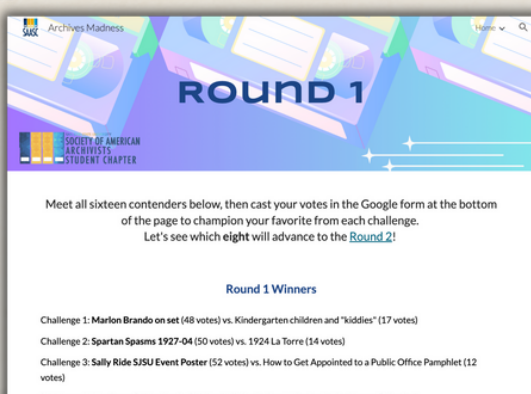
Putting the Pieces Together: Creating and Maintaining an Archives in a Regional Medical Center

Thera outlined key aspects of her work to highlight female students at MIT and preserve their legacies, notably through the recent exhibit "Under the Lens: Women Biologists and Chemists at MIT, 1865-2024."

SOCIAL MEDIA PRESENCE

The social media team promoted SAASC activities and blog posts as well as external archival events, internships, and job postings on Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, and TikTok. YouTube subscribers increased by 46 percent from the fall, from 112 to 164. Twitter impressions across the year totaled 3,573, with 1,000 impressions in March, coinciding with our Archeota and March Madness posts. Instagram followers increased by 21 percent. LinkedIn impressions reached over 1,000 in both November 2023 and March 2024.

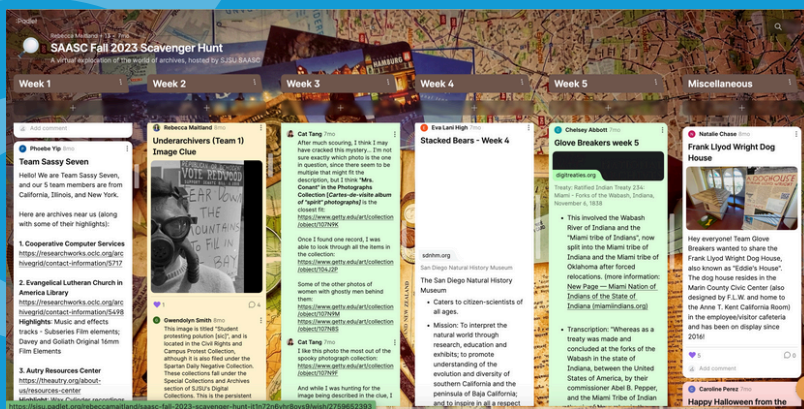
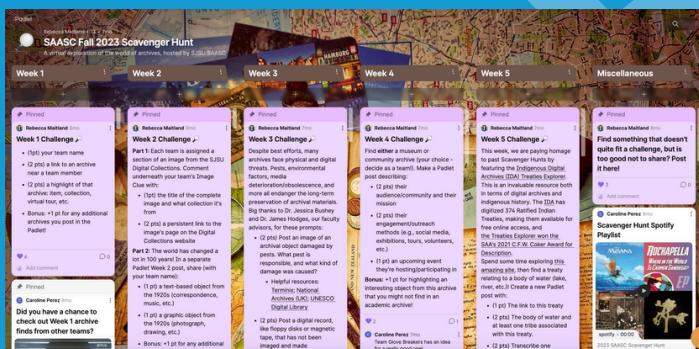
DISCORD

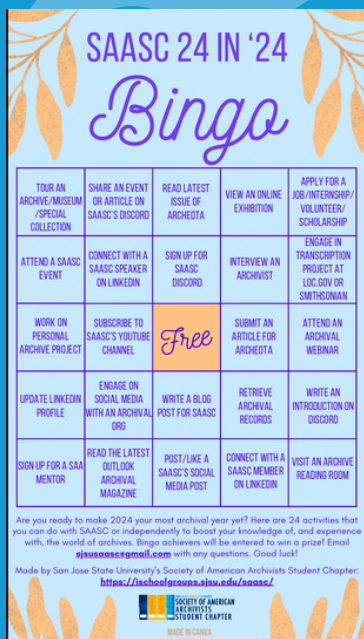
SCAVENGER HUNT
