Archival Worker Labor Task Force Annual Report

Executive Summary (up to 300 words)

The Archival Worker Labor Task Force (AWLTF) was charged by SAA Council in May 2023 to identify, analyze, and prioritize archival worker labor issues that SAA can influence. It was delayed in forming until early 2025. The task force kickoff meeting took place on July 16, 2025, with a subsequent meeting on August 13, 2025. The group plans to meet monthly going forward, with the September meeting dedicated to strategic planning.

AWLTF will soon engage in strategic planning to identify short- and long-term goals for the group that align with the TF charge. The co-chairs are currently working to submit a request to Council to update the original charge to reflect the extended timeline for this work. We aim to submit our final recommendations to Council in summer 2028.
