All honorees + Chair of Committee on the Selection of Fellows + Fellow Presenters + Awards Committee Co-chairs should arrive 15 minutes ahead of time and take a seat in the reserved seating section at the front of the ballroom. Look for SAA staff Teresa Brinati, who can provide direction and assistance. The script for the entire plenary, including the Fellows and awards presentations, will be in a binder at the podium. The awards and certificates will be on a table at the rear of the stage.

*SAA Vice President Meredith Evans and CoSA President John Dougan will open Plenary 1. After assorted welcomes and acknowledgements, they will segue into the awards portion of the plenary. **The order of the presentations is in the bulleted list above and will be in 3 groups as follows:***

All 4 Fellows + 4 presenters will be cued by SAA staff to proceed toward the stage together, standing in a row adjacent to the stairs to go up to the stage. Bell will approach the podium first to give a brief intro, then recede to the rear of the stage. Cooper Cary and Bastian will enter the stage, with Cooper Cary at the podium and Bastian standing adjacent to the podium and visible to the audience. After Cooper Cary reads the citation and presents Bastian as a new Fellow, she will hand Bastian a box containing the award and Fellow pin (those items will be on the stage). The audience will then acknowledge the new Fellow with applause. Then the Fellow and presenter will exit the stage on the opposite side, get their photo taken, and return to their seats. The next pair (Zanish-Belcher and Baxter) will enter the stage, and so on and so forth until the 4 Fellow presentations are completed.

Zamon will announce the first award for this group—Mosaic Scholarship—and as she does, the honoree if present will step toward the front of the stage adjacent to the podium and visible to the audience.

The Awards Committee Co-chairs and recipients will be cued by SAA staff to proceed onto the stage together. Kiniff and the honorees will stand in a row at the back of the stage. Zamon at the podium to present the awards. Zamon will announce the first award—Distinguished Service—and as she does, Abramson will step toward the front of the stage adjacent to the podium and visible to the audience. After the citation is read, Zamon will lead the audience in applause while Kiniff hands the certificate to the honoree. Honoree will then step back to the rear of the stage. Then the next recipient will step toward the front of the stage adjacent to the podium and visible to the audience. This process will be repeated until all of the presentations are made for Group 3. The Awards Committee co-chairs and Honorees then will exit the *opposite* end of the stage to get their photo taken before returning to their seats.

After the citation is read, Zamon will lead the audience in applause while Kinniff hands the certificate to the honoree. Honoree will exit the *opposite* end of the stage to get their photo taken before returning to their seat. Then the next recipient will enter the stage, stand adjacent to the podium and be visible to the audience, and so on and so forth. After the citation is read, Zamon will lead the audience in applause while Kinniff hands the certificate to the honorees. Lember & Duryee will then exit the *opposite* end of the stage to get their photo taken before returning to their seats. Then the next recipient will enter the stage, stand adjacent to the podium and be visible to the audience, and so on and so forth. This process will be repeated until all of the presentations are made for Group 2.

Zamon will announce the first award for this group—Mosaic Scholarship—and as she does, the honoree if present will step toward the front of the stage adjacent to the podium and visible to the audience. After the citation is read, Zamon will lead the audience in applause while Kinniff hands the certificate to the honoree, who will then step back to the rear of the stage. The

Forman Scholarship honoree will come to the front of the stage to stand adjacent to the podium and visible to the audience while Zamon reads the citation, and so on and so forth. This process will be repeated until all of the presentations are made for this group. After the last presentation, ALL honorees will exit the *opposite* end of the stage together to get their photo taken before returning to their seats. Zamon and Kinniff will also exit the stage.

The honorees will be cued by SAA staff to proceed toward the stage together. SAA Vice President Evans will be at the podium. Meneses, Shida, and Sykes-Kunk enter the stage and line up adjacent to the podium and visible to the audience. Evans will say a few words about the program then introduce each honoree. After the applause, the honorees will then proceed off the *opposite* end of the stage to an area where the photographer will take their pictures together and individually before they return to their seats.

Evans will next read the citation for the Council Exemplary Service Award, then invite Marciano onto the stage to accept the award on behalf of Michael Kurtz. The audience will acknowledge with applause, then Marciano will proceed off the *opposite* end of the stage, where a photographer will be waiting to snap a photo before he returns to his seat.

This concludes the awards segment of Plenary 2. Vice President Evans will then engage Archivist of the United States David Ferriero in conversation.
