### 3. Summary of student chapter activities:

This past school year our student chapter has been quite busy. At the beginning of the fall 2016 semester three new students were elected to the positions of Vice President, Social Program Chair, and Webmaster and Social Media Chair. New students ILS were introduced to the chapter at the first call out meeting in fall 2016. Chapter officer meetings were held throughout the year to plan events, discuss updates to the student chapter's procedures and constitution, and to provide opportunities to collaborate on future events and to update each other on planning.

The Student Chapter held Readings Sessions open to members throughout the school year. These featured speakers from around the IU Libraries and Archives professional community provided specific articles concerning specialized areas and topics relating to the archives profession for students to read and then lead informal discussion sessions with attendees. This year also marked the first large workshop event offered by the SAA IU Student Chapter in recent years. The workshops were well attended and provided many learning opportunities for the chapter officers. We hope to hold the event again during the next school year, and if possible we might try to expand it.

The school year ended with chapter officers updating the SAA IU Student Chapter Constitution and making plans for an election for open officer positions to be held in fall 2017. Overall we had a successful year and look forward to next year and meeting new members.
