

IMPACT OF NHPRC IN NEW JERSEY

The National Historical Publications and Records Commission (NHPRC) promotes the preservation and use of America's documentary heritage essential to understanding our democracy, history, and culture. Since 1964, the NHPRC has awarded \$207 million to 4,900 projects in all 50 states and special jurisdictions.

Total Cost of Projects supported by NHPRC in New Jersey:

- **\$17,399,978 - Total**
- **\$8,504,726 - Direct Federal Grants**
- **\$8,895,252 - State and Local Contributions**

Projects of Special Value to the State of New Jersey:

The NHPRC has played a unique role in supporting historical PUBLICATIONS and RECORDS projects of special value to New Jersey including...

- **Establish Network of Archives in New Jersey** – support to establish or enhance archives at such institutions as the Princeton University, Rutgers – The State University of New Jersey, Newark Public Library, William Paterson College, Newark Museum Association and many others.
- **State Archives Support** – funding to help modernize the state archives, improve access to its holdings, and prepare for emergencies.
- **Heritage support for Local New Jersey communities** – support for preserving historic records held at smaller New Jersey repositories.
- **The Papers of Thomas Jefferson** – funding to publish 83 volumes of the most authoritative and comprehensive edition of the correspondence and papers of the third President.
- **The Papers of Thomas A. Edison** – funding to publish 15 volumes of the technical, legal, business, and personal papers of the American inventor.
- **The Papers of Elizabeth Cady Stanton and Susan B. Anthony** – funding to publish a 6 volume edition of documents of the lives and accomplishments of the famous suffragists.
- **Access to the Papers of Diverse Americans** – project and/or press support for the papers of such historical figures as William Livingston, Woodrow Wilson, Phillip Mazzei, and David Avery.
