Meet the Bruce Springsteen Archives & Center for American Music

The Bruce Springsteen Archives & Center for American Music (BSACAM) at Monmouth University in West Long Branch, NJ serves as Bruce Springsteen's official repository and celebrates the history of American music of all genres. The collection holds close to 50,000 items dating from the late 19th century to the present. Monmouth University recently broke ground on a new 30,000 square foot building to house the Archives, related exhibition galleries, and a 250 seat, state-of-the-art theater. Join the **BSACAM Curator Melissa Ziobro** for an overview of the Center's history, programmatic and exhibition efforts to date, and an inside look at ongoing efforts to manage a major traveling exhibit while planning for a museum opening in 2026.



Melissa Ziobro began her career as a historian, archivist, and curator for the US Army in 2004 prior to returning to her alma mater, Monmouth University, to teach full time. She teaches over a dozen different courses, including Intro to Public History; Museums and Archives Management Basics; and Historic Site Preservation, Interpretation, and Management. In August of 2023, she became curator of the University's Bruce Springsteen Archives & Center for American Music, after having worked with the Center for many years in her faculty role.
