SAA President Nance McGovern will open Plenary 1. There may be an additional welcome from the Host Committee with a segue immediately into the awards segment of the plenary. ***The order of award presentations is in the bulleted list above and will be in three groups as follows.***

All 6 Fellows + 6 presenters + Chair of the Committee to Select SAA Fellows will be cued by SAA staff to proceed to the stage together, standing in a row at the back of the stage. Gregor Trinkaus-Randall will approach the podium to give a brief intro, then return to the back of the stage. Fellows will be named in alpha order. Jackie Dooley will approach the podium first with Robin Chandler standing adjacent to the podium and visible to the audience. After Dooley reads the citation and presents Chandler as a new Fellow, she will hand Chandler a box containing the award, Fellow pin, and Fellow ribbon (those items will be on the stage). The audience will then acknowledge the new Fellow with applause. Then the Fellow and presenter will retreat to where they were standing in the back of the stage and the next pair (Brenda Gunn and Rebecca Hankins) will go to the podium, and so on and so forth until all Fellow presentations are completed. The newly named Fellows and presenters will then proceed off the stage, where a photographer will be waiting to snap a photo of the new Fellows before they return to their seats.

The recipients will proceed to the stage together along with SAA Awards Committee Co-chairs Gerald Chaudron and Michael Doylen. The recipients will stand in a row at the back of the stage with Doylen. Chaudron will be at the podium and will present the awards. Chaudron will announce the first award. As he does, Doylen will hand the certificate to recipient and motion person to the front of the stage. Recipient will stand adjacent to the podium and be visible to the audience. Chaudron will read the citation (about 45 secs). After the citation is read, the audience will acknowledge the honoree with applause. Honoree will return to where he or she was standing on the stage. Then the next recipient will move to the front of the stage, stand adjacent to the podium and be visible to the audience, and so on and so forth. This process will be repeated until all of the presentations are made for Group 2. The recipients and Awards Committee co-chairs will then proceed off the stage, where a photographer will be waiting to snap a photo of the awardees before they return to their seats.
