# NEA/A.R.T. Spring Meeting March 22-24

This SAA Pop-Up Bookstore will take place at the New England Archivists (NEA) and the Archivists Round Table of Metropolitan New York (A.R.T.) joint Spring 2018 Meeting, March 22–24 in New Haven, Connecticut. The bookstore will be set up and run by Pubs Board member Mary Caldera. SAA will send one or two boxes of books and one box of materials. Hours will be determined by Mary's availability.

#### **Books**

The conference session topics are heavily centered on social justice, advocacy, representation, community archives, and digital preservation. Based on these themes, I suggest sending 20 books—a few copies of the following:
