In its seventh year, the St. Catherine University SAA Student Chapter continued the work of growing the organization by

March 2020

- Tours of the Minnesota Twins archive, the Mimi Holmes Art Collection at the University
 of Minnesota, and St. Catherine University's archives were scheduled but cancelled due
 to COVID-19 closures.
- Speed Networking event scheduled but cancelled due to COVID-19 closures.
- Chapter held a regular in-person meeting, but no other events transpired during the transition period.

April 2020

• The Chapter hosted on April 25th an archivist panel with a question and answer session. Panelists included archivists from the Walker Art Center, the Convent of Visitation School, and the Minnesota Historical Society. In addition, the book and paper conservator from the Minnesota Historical Society participated in the panel. Eighteen (18) students, two (2) former students, and Assistant Program Director Deb Torres attended.

May 2020

- The Chapter hosted a Netflix Party watch of *Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade* on May 1st. This event included informal discussion of the depiction of archives in the movie. Ten (10) St. Catherine University students and one (1) student from the University of Wisconsin attended in addition to Assistant Program Director Deb Torres.

- The Chapter completed the first part of its community project with the University of Wisconsin Eau Claire's James Newman Clark Crowd Sourced Transcription Project. The project consisted of students transcribing the field notes, diaries, and correspondence of the amateur ornithologist, James Newman Clark, whose notes from the 1880s and onwards played a major role in the seminal publication of *Birds of Wisconsin*. The community project was hosted virtually on October 24th over the platform Online Town. A total of six (6) St. Catherine University students participated in the event.

November 2020

- The Chapter concluded its community project with the University of Wisconsin Eau Claire's James Newman Clark Crowd Sourced Transcription Project. The project was hosted virtually over Google Meet on November 14th. A total of five (5) St. Catherine University students participated in the event.
- The Chapter hosted on November 21st an archivist new professionals' panel with a question and answer session. Panelists were archivists that had graduated from their programs within the past five (5) years. The panelists included archivists from Macalester College, George Mason University, and the University of North Dakota. A total of twenty (20) St. Catherine University students attended as well as the Chapter's faculty advisor Heather Carroll.
