## **Events and Activities**

## January 2021

- An officer meeting was held on January 14th to conduct preliminary planning for the spring semester.
- Officers attended a virtual new student orientation on January 28th to advertise the chapter and recruit new members

## February 2021

• The Chapter virtually attended a tour of the St. Catherine University Archive on February 22nd. There was a tour of the reading room and vault as well as a showcase of collections of the archivist's choosing. The event ended with a Q & A session with the archivist. Fifteen (15) St. Catherine University students were in attendance.

## March 2021

• The Chapter virtually attended a tour of the University of Wisconsin - Eau Claire Archives & Special Collections on March 26th. There was a tour of the reading room and vault as well as a showcase of collections of the archivist's choosing. The event ended with a Q & A session with the archivist. Twelve (12) St. Catherine University students were in attendance.

## April 2021

• The Chapter hosted an archive professionals panel on April 16th with a question and answer session. Panelists were archivists who have been in the field for five (5) or more years. The panelists included archivists from the Minnesota Public Radio (MPR), the

University of Minnesota - Twin Cities, and the General Mills archive. Twelve (12) St. Catherine University students were in attendance.

• The Chapter hosted a resume workshop on April 30th with open dialogue and discussion with panelists and students about general resume and cover letter tips as well as industry-specific advice. The panelists were comprised of the St. Catherine University Career Development Vice President and the Career and Special Development Manager. The other two panelists were hiring managers for the Minnesota Historical Society (MNHS) and the University of Ohio Archives. Fifteen (15) St. Catherine University students were in attendance.

# May 2021

- The Chapter hosted a Netflix Watch Party of *The First Line* on May 21st via the platform Teleparty. This event included an informal discussion of ethics around the repatriation of cultural artifacts to their country of origin, especially focusing on the role of the British Museum. Eight (8) St. Catherine University students attended.
- Officers attended a virtual new student orientation on May 20th to advertise the chapter and recruit new members.

# August 2021

- An officer meeting was held on August 26th to conduct preliminary planning for the fall semester.
- Officers attended a virtual new student orientation on August 30th to advertise the chapter and recruit new members.

# September 2021

• The Chapter held a regular in-person meeting, but no other events transpired.

# October 2021

- The Chapter held a virtual transcription and tagging session on October 16. Students registered for Citizen Archivist Missions on the National Archives website and performed tagging and transcription activities for World War II records, specifically the European Name Index to the Series "Case Files, 1944-1949." The transcription involved index cards that contained the name of an individual, a case number, and a summary of information from the case. The session was held over Google Meet and attended by four (4) St. Catherine University students.
- A tour of the Hennepin County Libraries was organized by Heather Carroll for the Preservation Management class on October 29, but members of the Chapter not enrolled in that class were also invited to attend. The first half of the tour focused on Special Collections, while the second focused on preservation and conservation activities. A total of four (4) St. Catherine University students outside of the Preservation Management class participated in the event.

## November 2021

- Several members of the Chapter attended the 9th Annual Minnesota Archives Symposium held by The Twin Cities Archives Roundtable (TCART) on November 1st. Chapter member Rachel (David) Johnson gave a poster presentation on scrapbook preservation as part of the event.
- The Chapter held a face-to-face community project session at the American Craft Council on November 13. Students processed several collections of archival materials, including records and marketing materials from the Art Jewelry Forum. A total of six (6) St. Catherine University students participated in the event.

## December 2021

- The Chapter hosted a new professionals' panel with a question and answer session on December 1st. All panelists had completed MLIS degrees within the past five (5) years and were currently working in archives-related positions. The panelists represented organizations such as WuXi AppTec, the Hennepin Medical History Center, and Aldis Systems, Inc. A total of ten (10) St. Catherine University Students attended the panel.
