- 1) Jodi Koste, Annual Meeting Task Force
 - a. Roundtables are changing and SAA is recognizing that, but SAA needs feedback before some "hard" decisions are made about how/when the roundtables will meet at future SAA meetings – possibly mixing roundtable meetings in among sessions and other events
 - b. The Task Force has received many requests for online discussion forums as well as the need for virtual meetings but both items can be costly to provide and support
 - c. It is difficult to implement new ideas even after they are approved by SAA, because contracts are often set years in advance

 - a. New HIPAA rules have been approved handout offered to attendees
- 3) Liz Phillips, Archival Elements newsletter
 - a. Thanks to all members who submitted content and for feedback on the latest issue

 - a. Nothing new to report, website is doing fine and she is trying to have old "news" items drop off the front page when they expire

 - a. Subscriptions are up slightly currently 323, up from 312 subscribers last year (334 in 2011, so we continue to stay in the same range of numbers)
