

## IMPACT OF NHPRC IN WISCONSIN

*The National Historical Publications and Records Commission (NHPRC) promotes the preservation and use of America's documentary heritage essential to understanding our democracy, history, and culture. Since 1964, the NHPRC has awarded \$207 million to 4,900 projects in all 50 states and special jurisdictions.*

### Total Cost of Projects supported by NHPRC in Wisconsin:

- **\$24,909,807 - Total**
- **\$12,811,647 - Direct Federal Grants**
- **\$12,098,160 - State and Local Contributions**

### Projects of Special Value to the State of Wisconsin:

*The NHPRC has played a unique role in supporting historical PUBLICATIONS and RECORDS projects of special value to Wisconsin including..*

- **National Leadership Institutes** – support for 40 years of the Historical Editing Institute and for four years of the Archives Leadership Institute.
- **State Archives Support** – funding to help modernize the state archives, improve access to its holdings, and prepare for emergencies.
- **Local Archives Support** – develop a municipal archives program for Milwaukee and assist local archives throughout the state.
- **Heritage support for Local Wisconsin communities** – support for preserving historic records held at smaller Wisconsin repositories.
- **Digitization Grant** – funding to digitize the papers of environmentalist Aldo Leopold .
- **First Electronic Records Grants** – a 1984 project to implement the Machine Readable Cataloging and Manuscripts Control process.
- **Early American History** – funding for the Documentary History of the Ratification of the Constitution and the Documentary History of the First Federal Elections.
- **Tribal Records Programs** – support to develop a tribal archives program for the Menominee Tribe and a Native American archivist training project at University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point.
